The award honors UTA members for their service and contributions to both the Association and the industry. It is awarded to a member who has elevated the Association in its mission to foster and promote the quality of the default services industry through extraordinary effort and dedication. Award winners are nominated by UTA's Committee Chairs and board members and final determination of the winner is made by the Board of Directors.

UTA membership is comprised of those acting as trustees under real property deeds of trust, including employees of title companies, financial institutions, and independent companies. UTA members also work in allied and support organizations, including posting and publishing companies and computer service firms. The Association currently has 322 members from 179 different companies. The UTA is a national, non-profit corporation.
