Dear Customer,

San Diego County, California has passed Ordinance No. 9988 which requires a "Foreclosing Lender Contact Information" form to be included with the recordation of the Trustee's Deed Upon Sale on residential properties.

Please provide our office with the contact name, address, telephone number and email address to be included in the Contact Information form. Should the property fall into disrepair with dangerous conditions, a county enforcement official will contact this person directly to rectify the situation.

Section 17.102 also sets forth that the document may be recorded subsequent to the recordation of the Trustee's Deed and requires the inclusion of the recording information of the Trustee's Deed. Section 17.102 also requires that a supplemental Contact Information Form shall be recorded when the current contact information for the foreclosing lender or authorized representative changes.

Section 17.103 provides that a civil penalty may be assessed in the amount of \$1,000.00 for each violation of this chapter.
